What Is Sustainability?



In recent years, "going green" has become increasingly important. Sustainability is a priority for our customers and for our associates and Kroger is "Doing Our Part" by focusing on a number of important sustainability issues

First – what exactly is sustainability?

OUR COMPANY'S DEFINITION OF SUSTAINABILITY IS A commitment to continuously improve our environmental and social impact in order to better our communities, the lives of our customers and associates, and to ensure the long-term success of our business.

Sustainability includes both environmental and social impacts:

- ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS Include the traditional topics such as waste reduction, energy use and emissions. For example:
- Our Columbus Division composted 650 tons of waste in four months.
- In 2009, the Portland, Ore., Fred Meyer store became our first LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified store. LEED is a nationally recognized standard for sustainable buildings.
- SOCIAL IMPACTS the other ways in which our company affects the lives of our associates, customers and the communities where we all live and work. For example:
- Through our Perishable Donations Partnership, we have donated 23 million pounds of fresh food. That equals 30 million meals in our communities.

Across our company, we're focusing on 5 strategic areas to promote sustainability:

- Reducing our carbon footprint and reducing energy use
- Reducing waste
- Improving transportation and logistics efficiency
- Increasing use of reusable bags while reducing plastic bags
- Enabling customer sustainability

Period 2 Safety Topic:

Strain & Sprain Prevention

Safety is No Illusion

"Working together, we can develop a culture that will reduce accidents to zero." Safety Creed

Make sure you stretch and warm up regularly and lift properly in the Green Zone-the area between the level of the shoulders and the hips. You can prevent injury by:

- Warming up hands, wrists and arms by stretching during repetitive tasks.
- Keeping wrists straight and the grip firm when handling heavy items.
- Lifting with the legs and keeping the load close to the body.
- Turning by moving the feet, not twisting at the waist.
- Using equipment for heavy loads or asking someone for a team lift.

Think Shrink: Shrink Smarts

Period 2 Shrink Topic: B.O.B.

How are BOB and shrink connected?

BOB shrink occurs when items placed on the bottom of the bascart are missed and not scanned at point of sale.

Examples of BOB shrink:

- Cashier and bagger do not notice BOB items, and the customer accidentally leaves with unpaid merchandise.
- Cashier does not check BOB items that could accidentally or intentionally conceal other items (i.e. coolers, TV boxes, etc).

In Celebration of St. Patty's Day... Here is an Easy at Home Recipe for your own Reuben Sandwich!

2 Slices of Rye or Marble Rye Bread

1/4 lb. Corned Beef

- 2 Tablespoons Sauerkraut
- 2 Slices Swiss Cheese
- 2 Tablespoons Thousand Island Dressing



Spread 1 Tablespoon Thousand Island Dressing on each side of Rye Bread. Place 1 slice Swiss cheese over dressing on bread, top with 2 Tbsp. Sauerkraut, top with ¼ lb. Corned Beef, top with another slice of Swiss cheese and second slice of bread (Dressing down). In sauté pan, melt small amount of butter or margarine. Brown Sandwich on 1st side, place small amount of butter or margarine in pan, and brown other side.
